## **Our Mission**

Orange Sky's mission is to **positively connect communities** and through our remote services we aim to improve wellbeing of the whole community, provide employment opportunities and a safe space for connection and support.

Our remote services have evolved since 2016 by listening and learning from over 30 First Nations communities and a broad range of stakeholders. Requests for our service from remote communities have related to better access to an essential service for improving health and wellbeing of the community, often relating specifically to improving skin health. Our service is part of a collective contribution to addressing skin health, rheumatic heart disease, general physical, social and emotional wellbeing, provision of employment opportunities, access to an essential service and the practical benefit of the service as a linkage tool in the community.

## **Our Services**

To support different communities with differing needs, we have responded by building three different asset types:



Three washers and three dryers, hot water heater, automatic detergent pump & solar power.



Suitable for mid sized communities where mobility isn't essential, with similar features to Remote Laundry Vehicles.



Two fixed washers and two dryers requiring a hot water tap, standard power point and waste water point to get up and running.

## **Partnerships and Responsibilities**

To deliver our service, purposeful partnerships are created with a local, trusted community controlled or community led organisations and, through this partnership, opportunities for meaningful employment are created and managed. Orange Sky maintains the responsibility for asset capital costs (asset maintenance, servicing and repairs; initial and ongoing training and service support; stock and PPE), yearly visits to connect with the community and team & provide ongoing training and maintenance.

Partnering with Orange Sky can help support fulfilling a range of policies objectives including the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health plan 2021-2031, Closing the Gap targets and Sustainable Development Goals.
